

PREPARING FOR YOUR VIRTUAL TRAINING

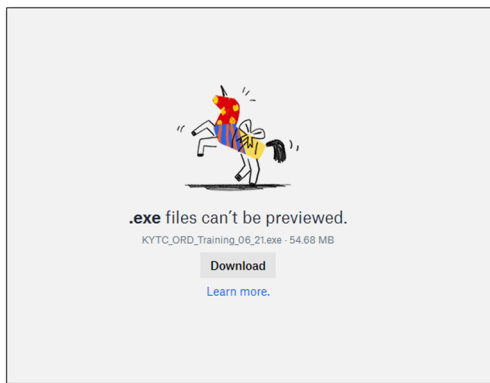
The ORD II training may be taken using **either** Bentley's Imperial configuration that is installed with the software, or the KYTC configuration. These directions apply to either situation. Steps that are specific to one or the other are noted.

***** You only need to set up one of the two configuration options. *****

Prior to the class, there are a few things that must be done on your machine; you may need the assistance of your IT department.

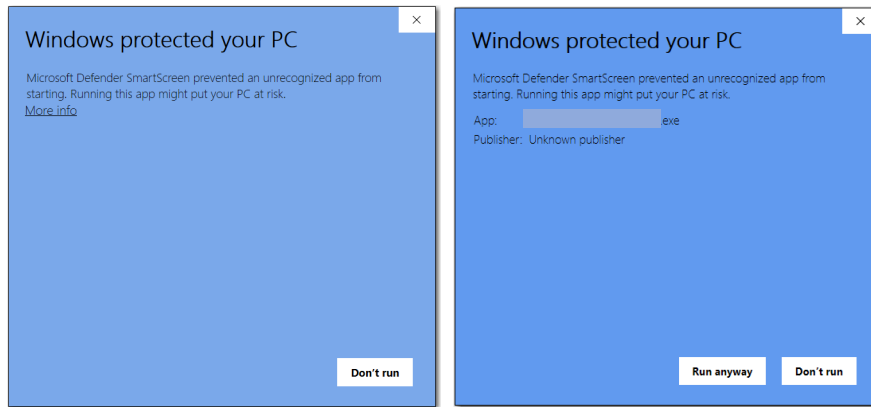
Downloads

1. You should have **OpenRoads Designer 2023 (2023.00.01.xx) or 2022 R3 (10.12.02.4)** installed on your machine. The book is specifically for these versions of software. (KYTC now uses 2023.) You can use a newer version, but there may be some differences with the book.
2. KYTC: Make certain the KYTC configuration corresponding to your ORD version is installed. Consultants can download it here: <https://transportation.ky.gov/CADD-StandARDS/Pages/default.aspx>. 3. Download and install the data files for the class.
 - a. If you have a *C:\Projects\ORD_II_Training* folder on your machine, remove or rename it.
 - b. Go to the **OpenRoads Designer** Dropbox download page here: [ORD II with Review Files.exe](#)
 - c. Select the **Download** drop-down and then select **Direct download**.



This downloads a self-extracting zip file. Your file name will be different than the ones shown in the images.

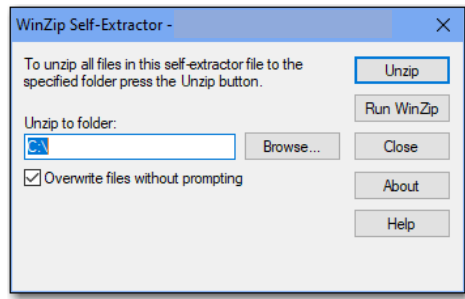
4. Double-click the *ORD_II_with_Review_Files.exe* from your download folder location.
5. If you receive a Windows warning message about an unrecognized app, select **More Info**, then select **Run anyway**.



6. If you receive any other warning from your virus protection software, select the option to run the program anyway.

The file may be unrecognized, but it is virus-free.

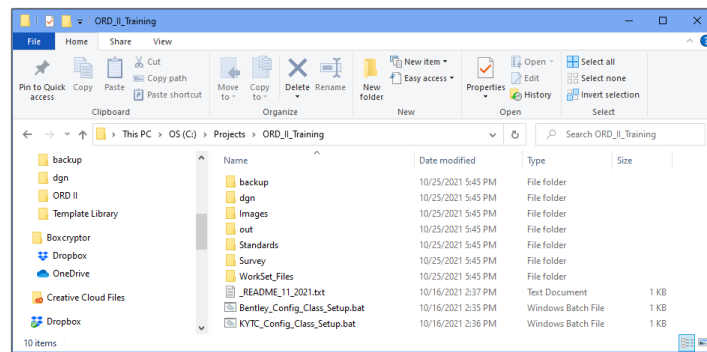
7. From the WinZip Self-Extractor window, verify the Unzip to folder location is C:\ then select **Unzip**.



After unzipping, select **OK**, then **Close** the WinZip Self-Extractor.

Important! Do not specify a location other than C:\ The extraction will create the project folder structure called for in class.

8. Check that you have a `C:\Projects\ORD_II_Training` with subfolders for the training class.



Important! If for whatever reason, you cannot or do not install the files in this location, see the *README* in `\Projects\ORD_II_Training` for additional information on installing the data.

9. KYTC Employees/KYTC Consultants: If your configuration is installed in the KYTC default local location of `C:\KYTC_Standards`, run the `C:\Projects\ORD_II_Training\KYTC_Config_Class_Setup.bat` file to copy the WorkSet files to the appropriate folder. If your configuration is installed elsewhere, the WorkSet files (.dgnws and .cfg) must be manually copied to the appropriate location from the WorkSet_Files subfolder (check with your IT department if you're unsure).
10. Others: If your Bentley configuration is installed in the default location, run the `C:\Projects\ORD_II_Training\Bentley_Config_Class_Setup.bat` file to copy the WorkSet files to the appropriate folder. If your Bentley configuration is installed elsewhere, the WorkSet files (.dgnws and .cfg) must be manually copied to the appropriate location from the WorkSet_Files subfolder (check with your IT department if you're unsure).

Test your setup

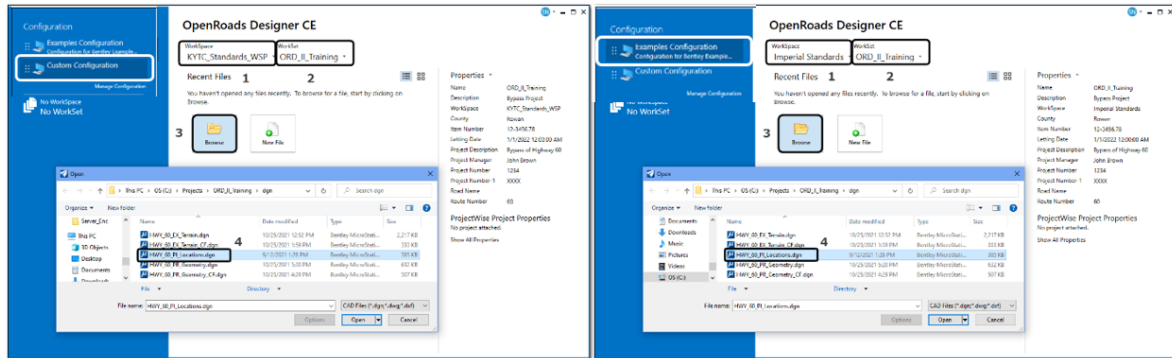
11. Start ORD
12. If you see a **Welcome** page, pick the arrow on the right side to go to the **Work Page** which is shown below.

KYTC Employees/KYTC Consultants:

Select Custom Configuration (or KYTC...) on the left

Select Example Configuration on the left



Note: Yours will say 'WSP' instead of 'WorkSpace' in the KYTC Standards.

These pictures were made in the 2022 version. The 2023 version will look slightly different.

13. Set the 1) Appropriate WorkSpace (either is sufficient, you do not need both) and 2) WorkSet as shown, then 3) **Browse** and 4) **Open** *HWY_60_PI_Locations.dgn*.

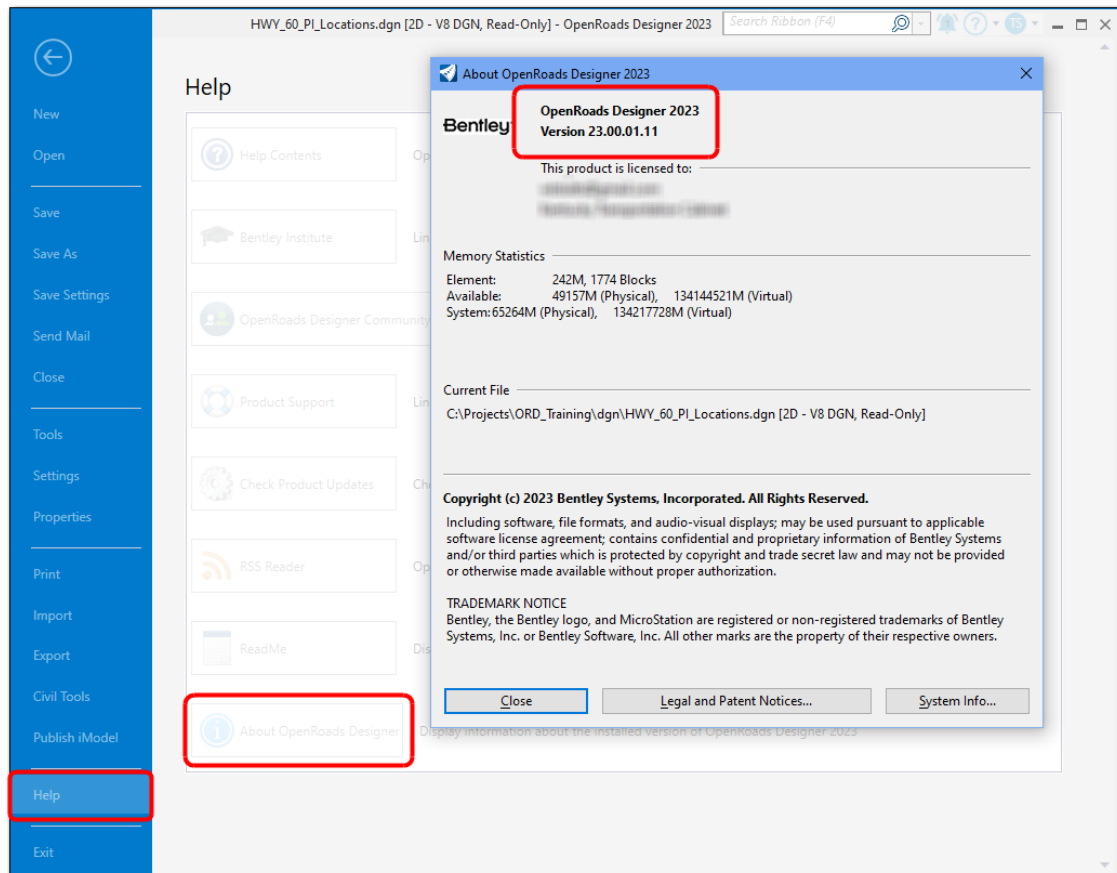
***KYTC_Standards_WSP** is part of the KYTC configuration installation. If you do not see it, the configuration is not installed correctly.*

***Imperial_Standards** is part of the default install of OpenRoads.*

***ORD_II_Training** is part of the data file installation. If you do not see **ORD_II_Training**, you do not have the data installed correctly. **Do not create the WorkSet**, be certain the data files are installed in the correct location and go back to either step 9 or 10 whichever is applicable in your situation.*

14. Select **Yes** if asked to Upgrade the file.
15. In the **No WorkSet Alert** choose the option to **Use active**.

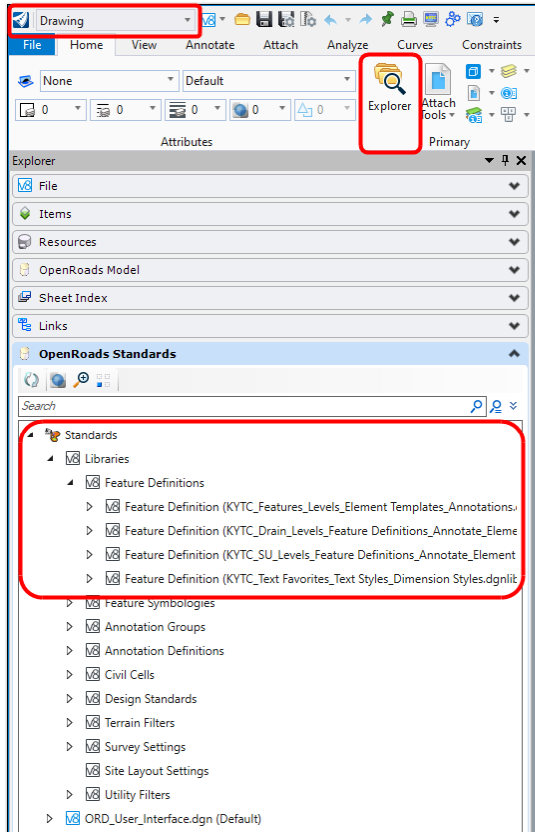
16. Choose **File > Help > About OpenRoads Designer** to check the version of software installed. You should have **2023**. The book is written specifically for this version; you can use 2022 Release 3, or 2024 but be aware there will be some differences in the book.



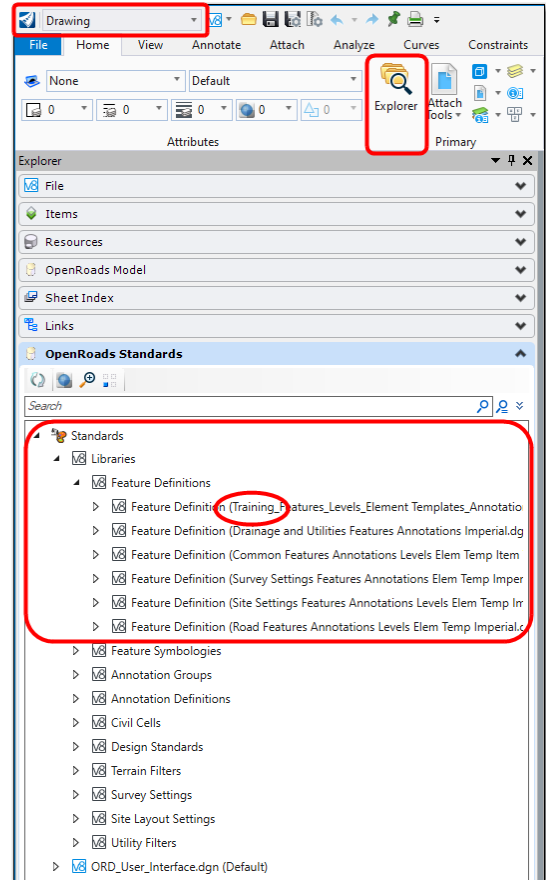
17. **Close**, then back-arrow at the upper left.

18. Choose **Explorer** and expand the categories as shown (this will take a minute).

19. You **must** see Feature Definition files, although they will differ depending up on your configuration as shown above. If you do not, either the configuration or your files are not installed properly. Consult your IT Department. Without proper installation of the configuration (either KYTC's **or** Bentley's) and the class data files you will not be able to work the class assignments successfully.

20. **Close** ORD after verifying you have the necessary files.

Prepare for Zoom

1. Zoom Client should be installed. Please download it here: (<https://zoom.us/download>).
 - For KYTC employees, if you have trouble downloading from this link, check the Software Center on your machine and try downloading Zoom from there.

3. You must have an internet connection with enough bandwidth to support video streaming.
4. A microphone and speakers (or headset) are required for the best experience.
5. A video camera is recommended but not required.
